The Bwaise Orphanage is located in a slummy suburb of Kampala with 46 Children at the time of reporting. 29 of these children are able to walk and help the other 17 children who can't move around properly due to different health and physical reasons. 3 of the Children in this orphanage are living with HIV and receiving support from RHU.

With one Care taker, who is also heavily ill at the moment and is permanently battling diabetes among other illnesses, the orphanage depends mostly of support provided by RHU and Individuals from RHU. Out of the 46 kids, only 21 children are in school from this orphanage, leaving the others behind. The criteria for selection of who goes to school has remained on a per capacity basis. (Someone has to express utmost capabilities of coping up in school without all requirements). School fees are currently being paid by two individuals from RHU, each of the nine children pays between 450,000 to 700,000 and scholastic materials between 160,000 and 300,000 depending on class. For the past few years, when one child reaches a demanding class (Candidate Class where graduation is attained), resources fail due to limitations in finances. This leaves children with only a chance to attain language skills (English Only) and basic education generally at primary level. The Paediatric Association of Uganda where Dr. Busonga is a former Chairperson is providing free treatment to the Paediatric HIV children at the orphanage, this excludes other required treatments for opportunistic infections which RHU now provides.

When it rains, (Which has been the case between September and December 2019), the flooding collects all the city sewerage to the orphanage compound. Children faced with malnutrition are affected more with the diseases that come along with the sewerage because many of them don't walk and they use their hands to crawl. Infection rates at this orphanage are unexplainable, children are living the lives no one would ever imagine and the standards of living including a place where they sleep is tear dropping.

With Continuous visits, medical support, special treatment and general support from RHU towards kids in this orphanage, we have seen some of the kids grow older and healthier. We can communicate with them verbally and we have conducted consultations with possible





support groups but we haven't received any positive results towards supporting these children. This is a sign that we need to do more to either move or help these children.

The third doctors have whenever convenient supported the orphanage. The demands and expectations of the children and their caretaker cannot be met properly but they have been appreciative of all the support provided and in their own words have constantly sent messages of thanks and praise to members of The Third Doctors, Engineer Nyanzi and Dr. Busonga. Questions of what to do next are always in play but the answers to that may be a far cry especially at a time when we also don't know what to do to help. We have appealed to government, friends and well-wishers to help but we still haven't found common ground.

Financial implications required at the orphanage

50Kgs of maize flour can feed the children for 6 days. This would include preparing porridge in the morning and Lunch but not dinner. 50Kgs of Maize flour cost 250,000 at the market. This can be prepared together with beans. 50Kgs of beans would feed the children for 6 days, the sack of beans cost between 300,000 and 340,000 dependent on the type (quality) of beans. This implies that feeding the orphanage children for six days would cost us between 550,000 and 590,000 without transport or any extras. (meaning their food is not spiced at all and their stew is not fried)

A better meal would cost the orphanage between 800,000 and UGX 1,200,000 in six days. A better housing condition for the children is highly require to effect change and control illness. The level of hygiene is hard to maintain in the current conditions. Refurbishing the orphanage is estimated to cost more money than RHU Or individual donors combined could come up with in a single time. Over UGX 212,000,000 would be needed to roof, clear the floor and renovate walls of the orphanage. There could be a possibility of providing land for the orphanage but the resources to construct are even more higher and possibly unaffordable.

Our Partners from South Korean, The Third Doctors managed to facilitate Beddings, Food through the festive season and some books for the school term that just started. This has gone a long way in keeping the children at the orphanage warm and their stomachs silent. We have managed to keep them healthy, paid some of their school dues, but for how long?





Although RHU has started requesting for funding from other sources, for the past 10 years we have depended on support from Dr. Busonga's Businesses and commitments, Engineer Rehemah Nyanzi and her businesses, A few companies and individuals. We have also received financial support from a constant donor The Third Doctors from the Republic Of Korea. These are the only current sources of which majority are not interested in supporting extra activities that are not health related. This has left Dr. Busonga as an individual and the Third Doctors as sole supporters of the orphanage.

We cannot tell how to raise resources for the children at the orphanage unless a strategy to fundraise is developed. This requires to understand that on top of the 1,200,000 required per week for feeding children, there's need for an extra few shillings to cater for other requirements and a seasonal contribution to cater for utilities. It also means that we must raise more money to refurbish the orphanage to accommodate healthy children. The task at hand would be a continuous weekly contribution that totals to a minimum UGX1,400,000 and a fundraising strategy aimed at collecting over UGX220,000,000

In this strategy, RHU would require to persuade government offices affiliated with environment, health and social welfare assessments to carry out free assessments to ensure compliance. We believe that as we submit these reports constantly to government, they will always adhere to our requests as they have constantly done so in the past.

For the past 3 years, RHU has had an interest in constructing a medical center (See plan in appendix), Which dream is to be shared with our partners, in this case we do hope that it does not hinder processes intended to complete this initiative for the orphans. If we were asked to choose between the orphanage and the RHU Medical Center, the answer would be the medical center because of its importance in the area to more than 5,239,123 people but that does not make the orphanage emergency any less important.

At this moment we are not aware of any individuals (besides Dr. Busonga), or entities committed to facilitating the orphanage at Bwaise. Support from our partners from the Republic of Korea is periodic and comes after special request and there is no commitment to it.

Real Health Uganda 는 시난해 배우 이려운 시간을 보냈습니다. 특히 온라다 사람들에게 의료를 제공하는 의료센터를 돕는 부분이었습니다. 우리는 우간다 전국의 영안실조로 고생하는 어린아이들과 여성들을 지원하고 의료기관들을 설립하기 위한 모금활동을 하는데 많은 어려움을 겪었습니다. 절망하고 포기하고 싶을 때도 많았지만, 당신들 덕분에 우리는 아직 여기에 있습니다. 감사합니다.

우리는 현재:

RHU는 아직 좋지 않은 단계에 미무르고 있습니다. 아직 많은 것들을 필요로 합니다. 우리는 정부와의 세금전쟁에서 이기고 지며, 우리들의 사무실 또한 위협받았고 현재 많이 축소된 상태입니다. 한국의 "더 서도 닥터스"와 지역후원자들로부터 받은 지원으로 2018-2019 년 한해 동안 13,553 명의 환자를 보는 상황에서 이리한 시무실 축소는 더욱 우리를 힘들게 하였습니다. 같은 해 집계되지 않은 16,732 명의 환자들은 어딘가에서 죽었거나, 어딘가에서 도움을 절실히 원하고 있을 수도 있습니다.

2019 년 6 월부터 11 월까지 RHU 는 치료와 예방이 가능한 질병으로 고생하는 고아를 뿐만 아니라 지역 아이들을 후원하고 있습니다.

우리는 2019 년 3 명의 고통 완화 치료증인 한자를 잃었습니다. 이 한자들은 고령한자들로 진료를 받기도 하였으나, 얼마 가지않아 사망하였습니다.




